### Admissions Criteria — Applicants must meet all the following criteria:

- Bachelor's degree in any major from an accredited university
- Undergraduate GPA of at least 2.85 overall
- Must have taken the GRE exam within the past five years
- A minimum of three years of full-time work experience, preferably in a public health-related position/organization
- Current full-time employment, preferably in a public health-related position

### Students will learn to:

- Use multiple sources of data to assess the health needs of a population
- Identify personal, social, political, and environmental determinants of health-related behaviors, morbidity, mortality, and health disparities
- Identify the most efficient and effective intervention strategies for improving population health
- Evaluate health promotion programs
- Develop scientific papers and presentations

- Accredited by the Council on Education for Public Health (CEPH)
- 20-month program, fully online
- 51 units, including 3 units of internship or practical experience
- Two 3-unit courses per eight-week session
- One-week break between sessions
