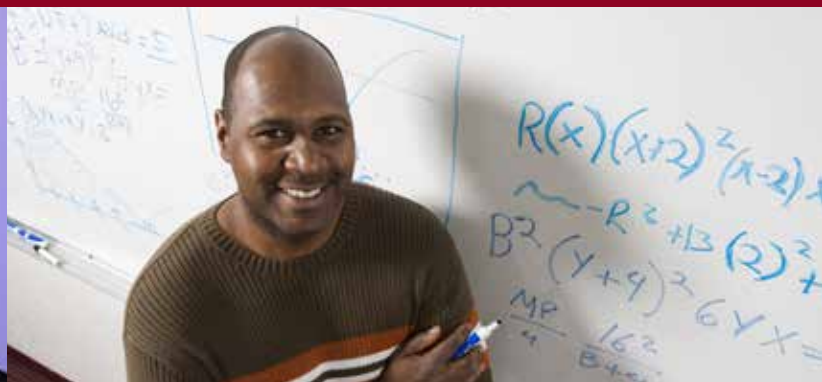


M.A. in Teacher Leadership
